SAMOA PARLIAMENTARY COMPLEX REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

The Government of Samoa, represented by the Office of the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly, has received grant funds from the Commonwealth of Australia for the construction of a new Maota Fono (Parliament House), and associated site and ancillary works (collectively known as the Samoa Parliamentary Complex Redevelopment Project).

The Office of the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly requests proposals from suitably qualified, eligible and experienced Consultants for the provision of Design, Documentation and Construction Supervision Services of Maota Fono Site Works and Podium Reconstruction at Mulinu'u, in accordance with the request for proposal (RFP) documents.

Broadly, the Services required encompass, but are not limited to:

- 1. Preparation of all design and construction documentation, including obtaining all necessary approvals;*
- 2. Tendering to construction contractors, through Government of Samoa processes;*
- 3. Construction supervision during the Contract Period and defects Liability Period;*
