AN ACT to authorise the issue and application of additional sums of money out of the Treasury Fund, to certain services of the financial year ending with the 30th day of June 1995 and to authorise the reduction of certain sums of money previously appropriated for certain services for that financial year.

[28 June 1995]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

1. **Short title**- This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act (No.2) 1994/1995 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Appropriation Act 1994/1995.

2. **Application** - Sections 2 and 3 and the Schedule of this Act relate to the financial period ending with the 30th day of June 1995.

3. **Amendment to Appropriation Act 1994/1995**-

The Appropriation Act 1994/1995 is amended by reducing the appropriations authorised pursuant to the Act by the sum of \$2,448,994 by effecting additions and reductions shown in Columns 2 and 3 of the First and Second parts of the Schedule of this Act.
