AN ACT to amend the Shops Ordinance 1961.

[22nd April 2005]

BE IT ENACTED the Legislative Assembly of Samoa in Parliament assembled as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement-(1) This Act may be cited as the Shops Amendment Act 2005 and shall be read with and form part of the Shops Ordinance 1961 (the Principal Act).
- (2) This Act shall come into force on the day it is assented to by the Head of State.
- (3) Notice of commencement of this Act shall be published in Samoan and English in the Savali and one other newspaper circulating in Samoa.
- **2. Interpretation** Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by deleting the words:

"Labour day which shall be the first Monday of August and that such a holiday shall be celebrated for the first time in the year 1995"

from the definition of "Public holiday" and replacing them with the following words:

"Fathers' day which is the Monday immediately following the second Sunday in August".
