### GOVERNMENT BUSINESS CONTINUED

- Debate continued on the second reading of the Electoral Amendment Bill 2014;
- The Hon Prime Minister moved a motion that the Electoral Amendment Bill 2014 be referred to a Select Committee after it is second read; motion approved.

### SUSPENSION

The sitting was suspended at 1:00 and reconvened at 7:00pm

### GOVERNMENT BUSINESS CONTINUED

- Debate continued on the second reading of the Electoral Amendment Act 2014 which was then second read;
- The National Health Service Bill 2014 was third read and passed the Assembly;
- The Hon Prime Minister moved a motion to:
  1. approve 38 Committee Reports pending consideration;
  2. 15 Government Responses pending consideration; and
  3. for the Assembly to consider the Report of the Officers of Parliament Committee on the Report of the Controller & Chief Auditor for July 2009 – June 2010 & July 2010 – June 2011; motion approved.
- The Minister of Finance clarified his position in regards to allegations set out in the Report of the Controller & Chief Auditor and subsequently resigned his seat;
- The Leader of the Opposition moved a motion to approve the Officers of Parliament Committee Report on the Report of the Controller & Chief Auditor to be approved; motion approved.
